## 2023-24 SCHOOL PROFILE

### OVERVIEW

Longleaf School of the Arts is a public, college-preparatory school integrating academics with fine and performing arts. All students are encouraged to pursue the most rigorous coursework, explore new art forms and deepen artistic skills. The first Senior Class graduated in 2016.

### CURRICULUM

Longleaf seeks to develop students who will make connections across disciplines to solve real world problems. To this end, Longleaf not only requires 4 Arts elective credits, but also a credit in Cognitive Development. Longleaf offers **46 Honors** classes and **18 Advanced Placement** classes. Students are typically only recommended for up to 2 AP courses sophomore year and none freshman year.
