



2019-2020 SCHOOL LUNCH INFORMATION

Hello, and welcome to Longleaf School of the Arts. Below is important information to assist you in being prepared for lunch each week.

Free & Reduced Lunch Application

ALL (new and returning) students who anticipate qualifying for either free or reduced lunch are required to submit a Free & Reduced Lunch Application each year prior to the start of school. You must submit an application to Longleaf even if you have submitted one to your County's Public School for other students. You may submit a copy of the student's County application or letter of certification to receive free or reduced lunches in lieu of completing LSA's application.

Buy Lunch

- LSA does offer the option to purchase school lunches by pre-paying through **My Hot Lunch Box**. See attached information. My Hot Lunch Box will be contacting all Longleaf households by August 7th with information on how to set up your account and order. Students that qualify for Free and Reduced Lunch will also use this program for ordering meals which will be supplemented by funds from the school. Qualifying families will be notified of their benefits.

Pack Lunch

Student's who do not buy lunch are expected to bring a packed lunch. Every effort must be made to ensure your student has a lunch each day while at school. The only alternative for a student who forgets their lunch is to purchase items from the snack cart. We have a room with multiple microwave ovens for students to heat up their lunch.

Lunch Behavior

1. No outside food is permitted to be brought into or delivered to the building.
2. If a student forgets their lunch, a parent may bring money for the snack cart before the beginning of the lunch period. This should only be a last resort. If this becomes too frequent, an Administrator will be informed.
3. On occasion, there may be extra lunches that may be purchased. Cash only.
4. Food is only permitted in designated eating areas such as the lunch area. No food is permitted to be eaten in classrooms unless authorized by Staff/Faculty.
5. Each student must clean up after themselves.
