# Topic - Parents/Guardians Role in School Safety

## How can LSA parents/guardians help keep LSA safe?

1. Encourage students to take responsibility for their part in maintaining safe school environments, including student participation in safety planning. (See Something, Say Something)
2. Remind students of the importance of resisting peer pressure to act irresponsibly.
3. Make sure you are connected to receive calls and messages from the school. (This is how information would be sent in the event of an emergency.)
4. Know if your child's friends have access to guns. Keep any guns in your home locked up and away from children of all ages.
5. Focus on building resilience and coping skills to manage disappointments.
6. Help your child be comfortable seeking help from a trusted staff member.
