Health Forms

Immunization records are required to attend school. If they were not included at the time of Registration, they should be turned in before the first day of school.

Students must have a form on file to take any medication at school.

Students with severe allergies, diabetes, or other chronic health concerns should have a Health Plan on file with the school nurse.

Course Placement and Elective Requests

Core Courses will be scheduled by Mrs. Winters based on Report Cards, Teacher Recommendations and Standardized Test Scores

English, Math, Science and Social Studies

Elective Requests will be made at the Course Selection appointment. The appointment link is available to families when Registration is complete in SchoolMint.

Arts Placement will be Studio I or Beginner unless you submit an Audition or Portfolio. Information can be found on the New Student Registration page of the Web site.

Graduation Requirements

Graduating Classes of 2024 and beyond must earn 26 credits to graduate. These are the differences from traditional school credit requirements:

LSA students must complete:

- 4 English and Math credits in high school.
- 2 World Language credits.
- 4 Arts credits.
- 10 hours of community service for each year of enrollment at LSA.

Typical Student Classes

English, Math, Social Studies, Science
Health and PE or World Language
2 Arts courses

LSA students may take Health/PE and/or World Language online WITH APPROVAL if they wish to make room for more Arts or Advanced electives.
LSA students may only apply for Dual Enrollment if they have maximized course offerings on campus.
